## TOWN OF AULT, COLORADO

## OFFICIAL PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR OF AULT PURSUANT TO AULT MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 13.04.200 REGARDING THE OUTDOOR USE OF POTABLE WATER ON PROPERTIES THAT ARE SERVED BY OR INCLUDED IN A NON-POTABLE WATER SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the aquifers and water sources that supply potable water to the Town of Ault, Colorado (the "Town") are becoming more limited and/or face increased demand;

WHEREAS, as growth continues in the Town and as residential and/or other subdivision developments continue to grow it has becoming increasingly important to even out the demands on the Town's water resources;

WHEREAS, it is very important, particularly in this year, for all citizens of the Town of Ault to conserve water to the maximum extent possible;

WHEREAS, there are some subdivisions which have dual water supply systems, a potable water system to be used primarily for interior residential use and a non-potable system primarily for irrigation of lawns, trees and shrubs and other outdoor purposes; and

WHEREAS, Section 13.04.200(C) of the Ault Municipal Code gives the Mayor the authority, by proclamation, to limit the hours of sprinkling or entirely prohibit the use of water for sprinkling purposes in case of shortage of water supply and provides that it is unlawful to use water for sprinkling purposes contrary to such proclamation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE TOWN OF AULT, COLORADO, and pursuant to Section 13. 04. 200 of the Ault Municipal Code:

- A. It shall be unlawful for properties and/or subdivisions within the Town that are served by non-potable water systems or that are included in subdivisions which use non-potable water systems to use potable water for any outdoor purpose.
- B. The restrictions set forth herein shall remain in effect until this Proclamation is revoked, modified, or otherwise set aside.
